

“Saima”

Saima is a 26 years young girl who got married at very young age because her father was died in her childhood. Her husband is a labor and his income was not sufficient to fulfill the household expenses, that is why after marriage she started Adda work and now from last five years she has been engaged with this work.

She is living in small house of just one room and this room is served as drawing room, bed room, kitchen and her work place. She is living in small area of Kahna Nau where there is no proper system of sanitation and sewerage and also she has to face load shedding of electricity which affects her work.

She works daily for 6-8 hours, during this time she looks after her children also. She gets work through middle man because no local market is situated near to her house. She wants to create direct market linkages for her work.

This homebased worker is not attached with any organization or group. However she wants to be attached with some local CBO. But she does not know as to how she can become a member of this organization. She does not know much about social welfare and social security schemes. The major issues and needs of this workers included getting more order work, better health facilities near her residence, opportunity to participate in the fair and exhibitions to introduce her skills and earn more for her family.
